

- I. DESCRIPTION:** Hale Creek Correctional Facility is classified as a medium security correctional facility and is located in the Town of Johnstown in Fulton County. This facility is used for the general confinement of males ages 18 and older.
- Hale Creek Correctional facility has a unit for parolees who are returned on a technical violation (45-day Parole Diversion Program).
- II. FUNCTION:** Hale Creek Correctional Facility offers Comprehensive Alcohol and Substance Abuse Treatment (CASAT) Program, Alcohol and Substance Abuse Treatment (ASAT), Alternative Drug Treatment (ADT), and Judicially Sanctioned Willard, Relapse, and Alternative Shock Placement programs. Hale Creek Correctional Facility also offers academic education, counseling, vocational training, transitional services, and Aggression Replacement Training (ART).
- Successful completion of the six-month CASAT Program can lead to work release or to a community-based residential program. Court mandated CASAT participants may be returned to general confinement until they are otherwise eligible for release to the community, if they did not receive presumptive approval for work release.
- The Hale Creek Parole Diversion Program (PDP) is designed to allow certain parolees, who have committed a technical violation of the term of their parole supervision an opportunity to correct their problematic behavior before it escalates to the point of re-incarceration. The Hale Creek Correctional Facility's PDP can accommodate a maximum of 48 participants.
- III. CRITERIA:** To be eligible for general confinement, inmates must be designated medium security or less. To be eligible for CASAT Program participation, an inmate must be presumptively approved for work release participation and be free of physical or psychological conditions which would preclude work release participation. Inmates may be placed in CASAT by Court Order provided they are medium security eligible, mentally and physically capable, and willing to participate in CASAT with no expectations of subsequent work release participation if they did not receive presumptive approval for work release. However, they may continue to apply for work release or any other temporary release program.
- Eligibility for the PDP requires the individual to be under Community Supervision and approved for participation after a technical parole violation.
- IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Hale Creek Correctional Facility consist of dormitories.
