

**I. DESCRIPTION:** Willard Drug Treatment Campus is a secure facility for confinement of males and females 18 years of age and older and is located in the Towns of Romulus and Ovid in Seneca County.

Willard Drug Treatment Campus is a unique facility created in 1995 by the Legislature under the Omnibus Sentencing Reform Act of 1995. The program is similar to the regimen of a shock incarceration facility; see Criminal Procedure Law section 410.91.

**II. FUNCTION:** Willard Drug Treatment Campus provides a 90-day program of intensive drug treatment services for:

1. Individuals who receive sentences of parole supervision pursuant to section 70.06 or 70.70 of the Penal Law; and
2. Certain presumptive release, parole, conditional release, and post-release supervision violators.

Treatment includes substance abuse and treatment services, academic education, vocational education, parole transition, physical training, network, and drill and ceremony, as well as aftercare appointments for both substance abuse treatment and Office of Mental Health (OMH).

Willard Drug Treatment Campus operates a DOCCS Regional HUB Recycling Center that provides industrial training. This operation is capable of handling, processing, and marketing recyclables received from other DOCCS facilities as well as other agencies and municipalities within their region.

Willard Drug Treatment Campus is classified as Mental Health Services Level 2, as defined in Correction Law, Section 2 (28).

**III. CRITERIA:** Individuals sentenced to parole supervision for class C, D, and E drug felonies and certain class D and E non-drug felonies must be second felony offenders; first felony offenders may be sentenced to parole supervision for certain class B drug felonies. The Board of Parole may place certain release violators at Willard Drug Treatment Campus pursuant to revoke and restore dispositions or alternative drug treatment dispositions.

**IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Willard Drug Treatment Campus consist of multiple occupancy rooms and dormitories.
