I. **DESCRIPTION**: Clinton Correctional Facility is classified as a maximum security correctional facility and is located in the Village of Dannemora in Clinton County. This facility is used as a general confinement facility for males 18 years of age or older.

Clinton Correctional Facility is classified as an intake facility for males 18 years of age or older at the time of sentencing from the counties of Clinton, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Hamilton, Herkimer, Jefferson, Lewis, St. Lawrence, Saratoga, and Warren.

Clinton Correctional Facility has a Special Housing Unit (SHU) and a long-term protective custody unit.

**II. FUNCTIONS**: Clinton Correctional Facility offers academic education, vocational training, counseling, industrial training, substance abuse treatment services, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), Sex Offender Counseling and Treatment Program (SOCTP), Video Visitation Program, transitional services which includes "Thinking for a Change," and a Family Reunion Program.

Clinton Correctional Facility offers the Assessment and Program Preparation Unit (APPU), an Intermediate Care Program (ICP), a Transitional Intermediate Care Program (TRICP), a Special Needs Unit (SNU), a Transitional Special Needs Unit (TRSNU), and a Residential Crisis Treatment Program (RCTP).

Clinton Correctional Facility is classified as Mental Health Service Level 1, as defined in Correction Law, Section 2 (27).

- **III. CRITERIA**: Incarcerated individuals of any security classification are eligible for placement at Clinton Correctional Facility.
- **IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT**: Housing units at Clinton Correctional Facility consist of cells for general confinement, and a SHU unit. The RCTP Unit consists of observation cells and a dormitory.
