I. **DESCRIPTION**: Coxsackie is classified as a maximum security correctional facility located in the town of Coxsackie in Greene County. This facility is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age or older.

Coxsackie has a Special Housing Unit (SHU), a Residential Rehabilitation Unit (RRU), a Residential Mental Health Unit (RMHU), and also a Regional Medical Unit (RMU).

II. FUNCTIONS:

- A. Coxsackie offers the following:
 - Academic education
 - 2. Vocational training
 - 3. Industrial training
 - 4. Substance abuse treatment services
 - 5. Under-21 programs
 - 6. Counseling
 - 7. Transitional services including aggression programs
- B. Coxsackie is classified as Mental Health Service Level 2, as defined in Correction Law Article 1, Section 2(28).
- C. The RMHU is classified as maximum security and is jointly operated by the Department and the Office of Mental Health (OMH) as a Residential Mental Health Treatment Unit for incarcerated individuals with serious mental illness, as defined in Correction Law Article 1, Section 2(21). The RMHU is classified as a Mental Health Service Level 1, as defined in Correction Law Article 1, Section 2(27). The RMHU program model is further defined in 7 NYCRR 320.2.
- D. The RMU provides medical care and treatment to incarcerated individuals in need; and for those incarcerated individuals who also require mental health services. The RMU is classified as Mental Health Service Level 1, as defined in Correction Law Article 1, Section 2(27).
- **III. CRITERIA**: Incarcerated individuals with a security classification of maximum B or lower are eligible for placement at Coxsackie.
- **IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT**: Housing units at Coxsackie consist of single occupancy cells for incarcerated individuals in general confinement, SHU, RRU, and RMHU, and a combination of single and multi-occupancy rooms in the RMU.
