- I. DESCRIPTION:** Elmira Correctional Facility is classified as a maximum security correctional facility and is located in the city of Elmira in Chemung County. This facility is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age or older.
- Elmira Correctional Facility is a reception and classification center for all males 18 years of age or older. Based on county of commitment, some are received into Wende Correctional Facility and transferred to Elmira Correctional Facility for classification.
- Elmira Correctional Facility has a special housing unit and a long-term keeplock unit.
- II. FUNCTIONS:** Elmira Correctional Facility offers academic education, vocational training, industrial training, volunteer services, counseling services, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), substance abuse treatment, a Sex Offender Counseling and Treatment Program (SOCTP), and provides Transitional Services.
- Elmira Correctional Facility is classified as Mental Health Services Level 1, as defined in Correction Law, Section 2 (27).
- Elmira Correctional Facility also operates an Enhanced Intermediate Care Program (ICP), a Transitional Intermediate Care Program (TRICP), a Residential Crisis Treatment Program (RCTP), and a Group Therapy Program (GTP).
- Elmira Correctional Facility operates a dialysis unit through a private contract with a dialysis vendor.
- III. CRITERIA:** Inmates of any security classification are eligible for placement at Elmira Correctional Facility.
- IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Elmira Correctional Facility consist of single cells for inmates in general confinement and special housing and keeplock units. The RCTP unit consists of observation cells and a dormitory.
