- I. **DESCRIPTION:** Rochester Correctional Facility shall be classified as a minimum security correctional facility and is located in the City of Rochester in Monroe County. This facility is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age or older.
Rochester Correctional Facility is also classified as a work release facility and a residential treatment facility.
- II. **FUNCTION:** Rochester Correctional Facility offers inmates counseling, volunteer services, substance abuse programming, and the continuous temporary release programs of Work Release, Community Services Leave (CSL), and Industrial Training Leave (ITL), through structured, closely supervised community programs.
Rochester Correctional Facility also supervises the Day Reporting Program.
- III. **CRITERIA:** To be placed at Rochester Correctional Facility an inmate must:
 - A. Be eligible for release on parole or become eligible for release on parole or conditional release within two years;
 - B. Have no convictions for absconding or escape offenses; and
 - C. Have a medical classification of III and mental health classification of VI.
- IV. **PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Rochester Correctional Facility consist of multiple occupancy rooms.
