- I. **DESCRIPTION:** Orleans Correctional Facility is classified as a medium security facility and is located in the town of Albion in Orleans County. The facility is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age or older. Orleans Correctional Facility is a residential treatment facility with a unit for parolees who are returned on a technical violation (Parole Diversion Program).
Orleans Correctional Facility has two Special Housing Units.
- II. **FUNCTIONS:** Orleans Correctional Facility offers academic education, vocational training, transitional services, volunteer service programs, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), Alcohol and Substance Abuse Treatment (ASAT) counseling, and Community Service Work Program.
Orleans Correctional Facility Parole Diversion Program is designed to provide parolees who have committed a technical violation of the term of their parole an opportunity to correct behavior before it escalates to the point of re-incarceration. Orleans Correctional Facility Parole Diversion Program can accommodate a maximum of 60 participants.
- III. **CRITERIA:** To be eligible for placement in general confinement, an inmate must be designated medium security or less.
To be eligible for the Parole Diversion Program requires the individual to be under Community Supervision and approved for participation after a technical parole violation.
- IV. **PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Orleans Correctional Facility consist of dormitories. The Special Housing Units consist of single and double cells.
