- I. **DESCRIPTION:** Sullivan Correctional Facility is classified as a maximum security correctional facility and is located in the Town of Fallsburg in Sullivan County. This facility is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age or older.
Sullivan Correctional Facility has a special housing unit.
- II. **FUNCTIONS:** Sullivan Correctional Facility offers counseling, academic education, vocational training, college programs, volunteer services, substance abuse programming, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), and transitional services (Phases 1, 2, & 3).
Sullivan Correctional Facility also operates an Intermediate Care Program (ICP), a Special Needs Unit (SNU), a Sensorial Disabled Program (SDP), and the Correctional Alternative Rehabilitation (CAR) Program. Sex offender counseling is offered in SNU and ICP programs.
Sullivan Correctional Facility is classified as a Mental Health Service Level 1 facility, as defined in Correction Law, Section 2 (27), with a Residential Crisis Treatment Program (RCTP) consisting of observation cells and dorm beds.
- III. **CRITERIA:** Inmates of any security classification are eligible for placement at Sullivan Correctional Facility.
- IV. **PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Sullivan Correctional Facility consist of single occupancy cells for inmates in general confinement and single cells in special housing.
