- I. DESCRIPTION:** Marcy is classified as a medium security correctional facility and is located in the Town of Marcy in Oneida County. Marcy is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age or older.

Marcy is designated as an under 21 years of age facility, specifically to house incarcerated individuals that have been diagnosed with a learning or emotional disability.

Marcy has a Special Housing Unit (SHU) and a Residential Mental Health Unit (RMHU) which is classified as maximum security.

II. FUNCTIONS:

A. Marcy offers the following:

1. Academic education which includes:
 - a. Title 1
 - b. Special Education services
2. College programming
3. Vocational training
4. Industrial training
5. Counseling
6. Substance abuse treatment services
7. Transitional services which include:
 - a. Aggression programs
 - b. Cognitive behavioral intervention programs

B. Marcy provides Relapse Treatment for male Temporary Release participants with medical and/or mental health service needs.

C. The Office of Mental Health (OMH) operates a Prison Based Sex Offender Treatment Program at Marcy.

D. Central Pharmacy Operations are located at Marcy.

E. Marcy is classified as Mental Health Service Level 2, as defined in Correction Law Article 1, Section 2 (28).

F. The RMHU is jointly operated by the Department and OMH as a Residential Mental Health Treatment Unit for incarcerated individuals with serious mental illness, as defined in Correction Law Article 1, Section 2 (21). The RMHU is classified as Mental

Health Service Level 1, as defined in Correction Law Article 1, Section 2 (27), with a Residential Crisis Treatment Program (RCTP). The RMHU program model is further defined in 7NYCRR 320.2.

- G. Marcy operates a DOCCS Regional HUB Recycling Center that provides industrial training. This operation is capable of handling, processing, and marketing recyclables received from other DOCCS facilities as well as other agencies and municipalities within their region.

III. CRITERIA: Incarcerated individuals must be designated medium security or less to be eligible for placement in general confinement.

IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT: Housing units at Marcy consist of dormitories in general confinement. The SHU and RMHU consist of single cells. The RCTP consist of four observation cells.
