NBC Feature Story On Former DOCCS Inmate Receives 4 Emmy Nominations

Dateline NBC Supervising Producer Dan Slepian, and the Dateline staff [were recently nominated](#) in four different categories by the National Academy of Television Arts and Science for several News and Documentary Emmys. The nominations [are for the feature "A Bronx Tale"](#), the story of former DOCCS inmate, Eric Glisson, who was wrongfully convicted of murder and eventually had his conviction overturned. Dateline's feature received nominations in four categories; Outstanding Feature Story in a News Magazine, Outstanding Video Journalism, Outstanding editing, and Best Report in a News Magazine. The 36th Annual News and Documentary Emmy awards are scheduled for September 28, 2015 at Lincoln Center, New York City. Dan has done extensive work at New York State DOCCS including most recently [participating in Sing Sing's 2014 TEDx Talks event and independently producing the Sing Sing gun violence video, "Voices from Within"](#).
