

Otisville Correctional Facility Staff Attend Burial of Korean War Soldier

On November 10, 2016, just prior to Veterans Day, Private First Class William Vito Giovanniello was laid to rest in Port Jervis, New York, 65 years after losing his life in the Korean War. Missing since 1951, the soldier—a great uncle of Otisville Correction Officer Drapala—was finally able to return home after his family worked for years to secure his remains. To show their support, several Otisville Correctional Facility staff attended the services, including two officers on horseback, honoring the soldier who paid the ultimate sacrifice for our freedom.
