

DOCCS Staff Present at 42nd Annual American Probation and Parole Association Training Institute

Several members of DOCCS community supervision staff attended and presented at the 42nd Annual American Probation and Parole Association Training Institute recently held in New York City. Deputy Commissioner Steven Claudio moderated a workshop presented by Assistant Commissioner Marco Ricci, Chief of Population Projections Jennifer Bryant, and RESET Coordinator Charles Figel. The presenters shared the Department's experience with its Recidivism Elimination Supervision Teams (RESET) initiative. This included an overview of the pilot program and a presentation by the Research Department on current findings for the first year of the program.

As part of a presentation on Collaboration for Reentry Success in New York State, Assistant Commissioner Ana Enright represented DOCCS for a discussion on the initiatives undertaken in New York. The establishment and success of 20 County Re-entry Task Forces (CRTFs) was discussed, as each CRTF has a co-chair from DOCCS who helps coordinate with representatives from the local county and local services agencies. The Governor's Statewide Council on Community Re-Entry and Reintegration was also discussed, which works to identify obstacles to re-entry and develops strategies to remove or effectively lessen them in areas such as housing, education, job applications, and occupational licensing.
