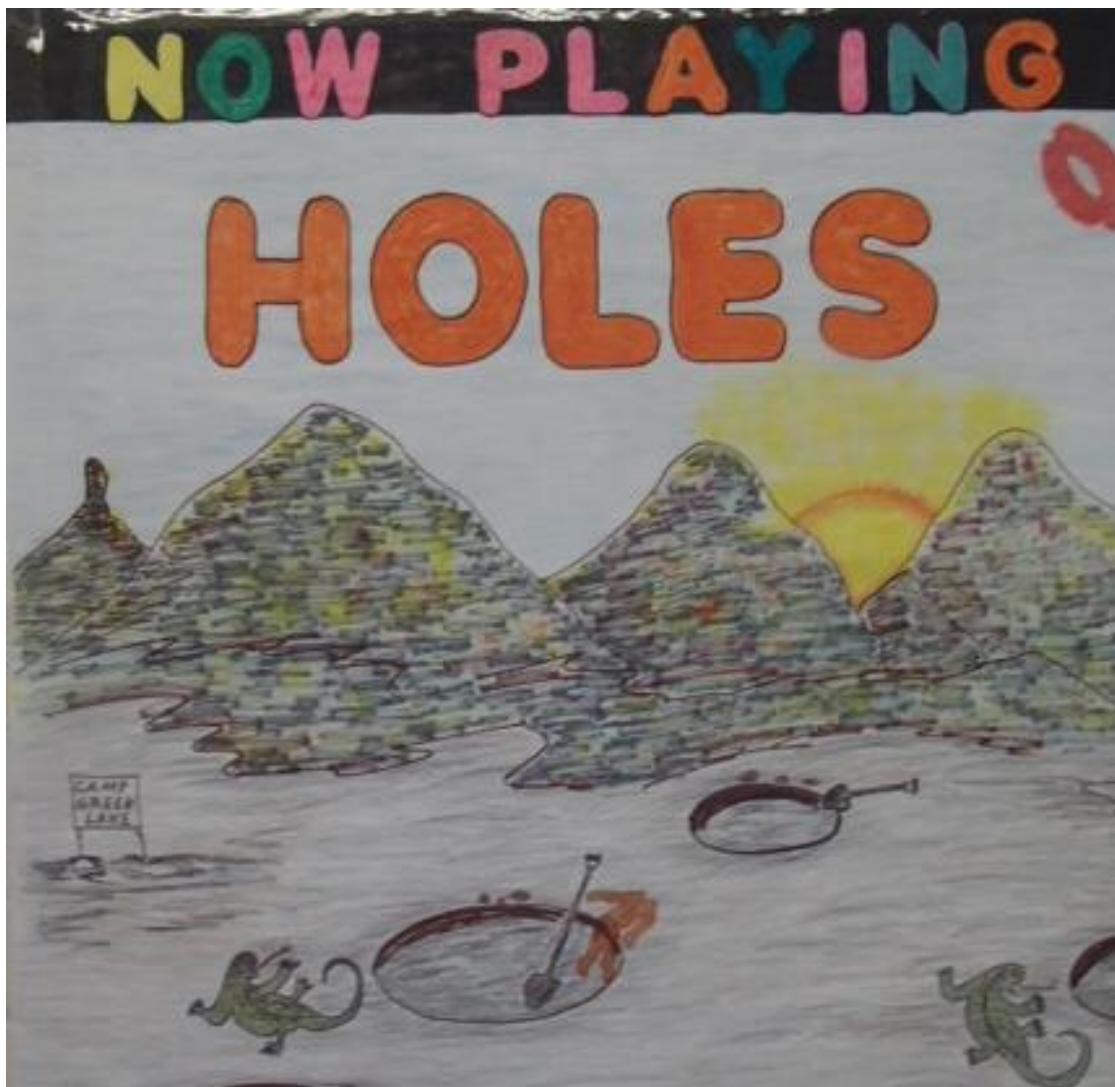




Corrections and Community Supervision
