DOCCS Staff & Inmates Pack Up, Ship Food to Houston for Relief

During the days following heavy rains and flooding in the greater Houston area the DOCCS Food Production Center packed and shipped items to be used in 40,000 meals that were assembled and handed out in Texas.

Among the items shipped were 41,000 individual cups of soup, 3,000 cans of tuna fish, 4,775 cans of sardines and 18,000 tea bags. The items were arranged and organized by facility staff and packed and loaded into shipping trucks with the assistance of the inmates who work at the food production center.

Located in Rome, The Food Production Center opened in 1992 and provides approximately 40% of the daily meals offenders consume across the state.
