

Livingston Correctional Facility Inmates Host Food Drive

The Life Awareness Society Organization at Livingston Correctional Facility hosted a 30-day food drive, set up as a challenge to see which inmate dorm could collect the most donations. Between Livingston's 14 dorms, 362 pounds of food were donated, along with donations used to purchase non-perishable items from the commissary. The items collected during the drive were donated to the Dimitri House in Rochester, an organization that gives back to youth in the community and helps to feed low income families in the area.
