Albion Correctional Facility Raises Money for HIV Awareness

For the third consecutive year the Albion Correctional Facility held its annual AIDS Walk to raise money for local groups in the fight against the disease. Participants in the 5K walk helped raise awareness and funds for those living with and being affected by HIV. This year was the largest yet with 145 participants. This year's event was sponsored by facility staff, the inmate population, and members of the community. In all \$1,262.32 was raised with \$499.99 donated by the Inmate Liaison Committee. The funds were given to the Rochester Area Task Force on AIDS (RATFA).

This is the second year AIDS Walk funds have been donated to RATFA, to support their efforts in raising awareness and provide an open forum for information sharing in the Finger Lakes Region. RATFA is dedicated to reducing the prevalence of HIV while promoting the availability of comprehensive, compassionate and quality care for all persons affected.
