The New York State Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS) is currently accepting applications for state employee staff physicians: Clinical Physician 1 and Clinical Physician 2.

Both full and part-time Clinical Physician 1 and Clinical Physician 2 position vacancies exist in one or more of our 60 Correctional Facilities located throughout New York State.

Most physicians, work during normal business hours, Monday through Friday. However, Physicians are responsible for sharing "on-call" phone responsibilities for evenings, weekends, and all New York State holidays.

All levels of work experience, including new graduates, are welcome. Current New York State license and registration are required.
