

WIVB: Dad allegedly sends drugs to inmate son

A Brooklyn man is accused of sending drugs to his son who is in jail.

New York State Police said Daniel Valazquez sent Subozone to his son in greeting cards in August and September. Valazquez's son is an inmate at Lakeview Shock, in Brocton.

Valazquez is charged with four counts of felony first-degree promoting prison contraband. He was arraigned in Town of Portland Court and remanded to the Chautauqua County Jail with no bail.
