## **Statistical Overview**

### **Year 2006 Court Commitments**

This document describes the characteristics of inmates admitted to the New York State Department of Correctional Services during calendar year 2006 (N=26,944). The report concentrates on inmates admitted into a state prison facility for the first time on their current sentence (N=16,867). This overview presents information on various data points such as commitment offense, felony class, category of commitment offense, age at commitment, county of commitment and minimum sentence length. For comparative purposes, multiple tables throughout the report show trends in admission data across the years 2002 through 2006.

### Section 1: Type of Admission

There were a total of 26,944 admissions to the facilities of the Department of Correctional Services during 2006 (see Table 1.1). Of the total admissions, 16,867 (63%) were new court commitments, another 9,413 (35%) were returned parole violators, and 664 (2%) were other admissions.

**(2006 Total Admissions, N=26,944)**



## Section 2: Commitment Offense

Twenty-nine percent (4,878) of new court commitments in 2006 were violent felony offenders, 36% (6,060) were drug offenders, 10% (1,741) were other coercive crime offenders, 21% (3,527) were property crime offenders, and 4% (661) were juvenile/youthful offenders.

After several years of dropping in proportion, the percentage of newly committed drug offenders leveled off in 2005 and 2006 to about 36%. The proportion of violent offender new commitments was stable over the timeframe at just less than 30% and the proportion of property offenders increased from 18% in 2002 to 21% in 2006.

### Section 3: Second Felony Offender Status

More than half (55%) of 2006 new court commitments were sentenced as first felony offenders. Conversely, 45% were sentenced as second felony offenders, and less than one percent (0.7%) were sentenced as persistent offenders.

Individuals sentenced as first felony violent commitments outnumbered second and persistent felons by a 2 to 1 margin.



### Section 4: Felony Class Category

Over 3% of 2006 new court commitments were Class A-I or Class A-II felons. Eighty-two percent (218 of 267) of the A-I commitments were for violent felony offenses. All A-II felons were committed for drug felonies.

Class B and Class C each comprised 20% of new court commitments; Class D felons were the largest subset, encompassing 35% of new commitments in 2006. Class E offenders constituted 18% and Youthful Offenders represented nearly 4% of 2006 new commitments.



**Section 5: Maximum and Minimum Sentences**


The minimum sentence reflects the shortest period of time that a person must serve before being considered for release on parole. For violent felons (VFO) and non-violent felons (non-VFO), the average minimum sentence was relatively stable in admission years 2002 through 2004 (84 and 30 months, respectively), but both declined somewhat by 2006 (80 and 26 months, respectively). The average minimum term for Youthful/Juvenile offenders was stable for the time period at approximately 16 months.

The overall minimum sentence for all types of crime followed the same pattern as VFO, steady at 45 months from 2002 through 2004 before decreasing to 41 months in 2006.



**Section 6: Prior Adult Criminal Record**

Nearly 60% of new court commitments in 2006 had served a prior period of time in jail (29%) or prison (29%). Approximately 20% had been convicted of a prior crime but didn't serve time, and 21% had never been convicted of a crime.

## Section 7: Drug Commitments

Of those new commitments admitted in 2006 for a drug offense, the majority (59%) were incarcerated for drug sale, the remainder for drug possession (41%).

The number of drug commitments declined by nearly 1,000 between 2002 (6,644) and 2004 (5,665), but rose by almost 400 between 2004 and 2006 (6,060) (see Table 7.2).

Determinate sentencing for drugs began in 2005 (see Section 17 of this report). This accounted for the significant drop in maximum sentences from 90 months in 2004 to 63 months in 2005 and 42 months in 2006, as a higher proportion of commitments arrived with determinate sentences.

### Section 8: Gender

Males made up 93% of 2006 new court commitments. Approximately 96% of newly committed violent felons were men.

The proportion of men who were violent felons (30%) was nearly double the proportion of women who were violent felons (16%). Women were more likely than men to be committed for drug offenses (43% and 35%, respectively) and property offenses (31% and 20%, respectively).

**(2006 New Court Commitments, N=16,867)**



### Section 9: Race/Ethnic Status

Just under half of new commitments annually have been African-Americans throughout the period 2002-2006. The proportion of Whites in the admission group increased from 20% to 24% over the period. This was offset by a corresponding decrease in the proportion of Hispanics from 31% to 27%.

### Section 10: Age at Admission

Average age at admission has remained stable at approximately 32 years over the period 2002 through 2006. The percentage of new court commitments age 40 and over has increased over the timeframe; 20% of 2002 new court commitments were 40 or older versus 25% in 2006.

### Section 11: County and Region of Commitment

Nearly half (47%) of new court commitments in 2006 were from New York City boroughs, 12% were from suburban New York City counties, 21% were from Upstate Urban counties and 19% were from the remaining Upstate counties. The percentage of new court commitments from New York City has decreased annually in recent years from 57% in 2002 to 47% in 2006 (see Table 11.1).

A higher proportion of men were from New York City than women (48% and 41%, respectively) and a higher proportion of women were committed from non-urban Upstate counties than men (28% and 19%, respectively) (see Table 11.2).

Commitments from New York City and suburban New York City were most likely to be drug felons (approximately 40%); the highest proportion from Upstate Urban counties were violent felons (32%) and from the remaining Upstate counties, the highest concentration was among property offenders (35%) (see Table 11.3).

**(2006 New Court Commitments, N=16,867)**



**Section 12: Country of Birth**

Approximately 90% of 2006 new court commitments were born in the United States or in U.S. possessions, 5% in a Caribbean nation, 1% in South America, and approximately 4% in all other countries.

While drug offenders were 36% of all new commitments, they comprised 51% of commitments born in U.S. possessions and 49% of those born in Caribbean nations.

(2006 New Court Commitments, N=16,867)**



### Section 13: Educational Level

Based on tests administered at reception to the Department, the average reading level was 7<sup>th</sup> grade among 2006 new court commitments; the average math level was 6<sup>th</sup> grade (see Tables 13.1 and 13.2).

Both math and reading levels have increased somewhat among new court commitments since 2002. Reading increased from grade level 6.8 in 2002 to 7.3 in 2006; math scores increased from grade level 6.2 in 2002 to 6.4 in 2006 (see Tables 13.1 and 13.2).

**(2006 New Court Commitments)**



### Section 14: Marital Status

Among 2006 new court commitments, 74% were single, never married; 2% reported common law marriages; 15% reported that they were married, and 9% were divorced, separated or widowed.

Women were more likely than men to report that they were married (20% and 14%, respectively) and more likely to report that they were divorced, widowed, or separated than were men (13% and 9%, respectively).

### Section 15: Jail Time

Time spent in local jail prior to commitment to state prison is credited toward service of the minimum term. Average jail time served by new commitments in 2006 was 6.7 months. This number remained relatively constant from 2002 to 2006, ranging from 6.7 to 6.9 months (see Table 15.1).

On average from 2002-2006, inmates from New York City (7.8 months) and Suburban New York (7.4 months) spent more time in local jails than inmates from Upstate Urban (5.3 months) and Upstate Other (5.0 months) counties. These values have remained constant for Upstate Urban and Upstate Other counties over the time period, decreased for Suburban New York (7.4 months in 2002 to 6.8 months in 2006), and increased for New York City (7.5 months in 2002 to 8.1 months in 2006) (see Table 15.2).

### Section 16: Life Without Parole

A person convicted of the crime of murder in the first degree may be sentenced to life imprisonment without parole. Persons sentenced to Life Without Parole are not eligible for parole or conditional release.

In 2006, there were 15 men and 1 woman admitted to NYS prison facilities with a Life Without Parole sentence (see Table 16.1). Ten were African American, 4 were Hispanic, 1 was White and 1 was listed as Other. These 16 cases were spread around the state in terms of region of commitment (4 from New York City, 5 from Suburban New York, 4 from Upstate Urban, and 3 from Upstate Other).

Of the 83 people sentenced to Life Without Parole over the last 5 years, 25% (21) ranged in age from 30-34 at the time of admission. The youngest offender with a Life Without Parole sentence was 19 at admission to DOCS while the oldest was 66.

### Section 17: Determinate Sentencing

Inmates with determinate sentences on their top crime encompassed 56% of new court commitments in 2006; over half (54%) were administered to first felony offenders (see Table 17.1).

The growing number of determinately sentenced cases is due primarily to the drug sentencing reforms enacted in December 2004. Determinately sentenced drug cases more than doubled from 2,177 in 2005 to 5,049 in 2006. Overall, the total number of determinately sentenced new commitments increased from 6,637 in 2005 to 9,538 in 2006 (see Table 17.2).
