Statistical Overview

Year 2006 Discharges

This document describes the characteristics of inmates discharged from the New York State Department of Correctional Services during calendar year 2006 (N=26,394). The report concentrates on inmates released into the community for the first time on their current sentence (N=16,662). This overview presents information on length of time served in custody according to various legal history criteria such as commitment offense, felony class, category of commitment offense and minimum sentence length. For comparative purposes, two tables show trends in time served in custody across the years 2002 through 2006.

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
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Section 1: TYPE OF RELEASE

There were a total of 26,394 releases from the facilities of the Department of Correctional Services during 2006 (see Table 1). Of the total releases, 12,914 (49%) were individuals released to parole supervision as a result of Parole Board decisions, another 9,098 (35%) were released to parole supervision after reaching their conditional release date, and 2,749 (10%) were released with no further supervision as a result of serving time until the maximum expiration of their sentence. There were also 617 (2%) offenders who served time in custody until the maximum expiration of their sentence, but were required by law to be supervised by the Division of Parole following release to the community (Maximum Expiration with Post Release Supervision).

(2006 Total Releases, N=26,394)




The tables in subsequent sections of this report are based on the 16,662 inmates who were released to the community for the first time on their current sentence due to release by the Board of Parole (7,165); release resulting from reaching their conditional release date, including maximum expiration with post release supervision (8,883); or release based on reaching maximum expiration of sentence (614) (see Figure 1-A).


Figure 1A

Section 2: COMMITMENT OFFENSE BY GENDER

Seven percent (1,189) of first releases were women and 93% (15,473) were men. A larger proportion of men released in 2006 (30%) were committed for violent felonies than women (16%). Conversely, a larger proportion of women released were committed for drug offenses and property offenses (47% and 28%, respectively) than were men (38% and 19%, respectively) (see Figure 2).

Of the 16,662 first releases in 2006, 29% (4,862) were committed for violent felony offenses, 10% (1,610) for other coercive offenses, 38% (6,410) for drug offenses, 19% (3,219) for property and other types of offenses, and 3% (561) as Youthful or Juvenile Offenders (see Table 2).

Section 3: *TIME SERVED BY COMMITMENT OFFENSE*

The average "total time served" (i.e., state time plus jail time) for first releases in 2006 was 43 months and the median was 31 months. The average "state time only" for these releases was 37 months and the median was 23 months (see Table 3).

TIME SERVED BY SECOND FELONY OFFENDER STATUS

Repeat felony offenders generally serve longer prison sentences than first felony offenders. On average, second and persistent felony offenders were incarcerated 5 months longer (46 months) than first felony offenders (41 months). Second and persistent violent felons served an average of 16 months more time than first-time violent felons (see Table 4).

TRENDS IN TIME SERVED (2002-2006)

The average time served for *all* first releases remained relatively constant for the last five years. Violent felons spent an average of 75 months in custody among 2006 releases, compared with an average of 72 months among 2002 releases. Comparing 2005 to 2006 first release drug offenders, the average time served decreased by 13% (36 months to 31 months), following the drug sentencing reforms enacted in December 2004.


Section 4: TIME SERVED BY FELONY CLASS

FELONY CLASS BY FELONY OFFENDER STATUS

Class A-I and A-II felons accounted for 4% of the inmates released in 2006 (1% for Class A-I and 3% for Class A-II) (see Table 6). Twenty-one percent of the first releases were committed for Class B felonies; 18% for Class C; 36% for Class D; 18% for Class E felony offenses, and 3% were Youthful Offenders. Time served by felony crime class is presented in Figure 3 and shows that Class A-I felony offenders served the longest period of time in custody while Youthful Offenders served the shortest.

Table 8 shows average and median minimum sentence and time served by felony crime class. The cases are grouped into violent, non-violent and youthful / juvenile offense categories within the two predicate felony statuses. First felony offenders convicted of a violent offense served an average of 69 months whereas non-violent, first felons served an average of 25 months. Predicate felony offenders convicted of a violent felony served an average of 85 months, while non-violent predicate felony offenders served an average of 35 months.


TRENDS IN TIME SERVED BY VIOLENT FELONY OFFENDERS

Average time served for violent felony offenders increased between 2002 and 2006. For first felony offenders convicted of a violent crime, the average total time served increased from 64 months among 2002 first releases to 69 months among 2006 first releases (see Table 9 and Figure 4). The average time served by second and persistent felony offenders convicted of a violent felony has remained relatively constant for the last four years.

Section 5: *TIME SERVED BY MINIMUM SENTENCE LENGTH*

The total time served for 2006 first releases was similar to minimum sentence length. However, a number of the first release population's total time served fell below the court set minimum sentence (see Table 10). This results primarily from offenders that successfully complete early release programs such as Shock Incarceration or Merit Time eligibility.

Section 6: *TIME SERVED FOR DRUG OFFENDERS*

The average total time served for drug offenders in the 2006 first release population was 31 months. On average, second and persistent felony drug offenders served more time (36 months) than first felony drug offenders (24 months) (see Table 11).


Among 2006 releases, the average time served for A-I drug felons sentenced as second felony offenders was 143 months; 7 months less than the group's average minimum sentence. The average time served for first felony A-I drug felons was 158 months; 5 months more than the average minimum sentence for this group.

A statistical anomaly seems to have occurred among the A-I drug releases in 2006. Interestingly, the average minimum sentence for released A-I first-time felons was 4 months longer than A-I second and persistent felons.

Section 7: *DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS*

GENDER AND RACE/ETHNIC STATUS

Forty-three percent of the women and 48% of the men in the 2006 first release population were African-American. Twenty-three percent of the women released were Hispanic, whereas 30% of the men were Hispanic. Twenty-one percent of men and 33% of female releases were White (see Table 12).

AGE AT RELEASE

The average age of inmates at the time of release was 34 years old. Female inmates released in 2006 were, on average, 2 years older (age 36) than male inmates (age 34). White inmates were slightly older at release (age 36) than African American inmates (age 33) and Hispanic inmates (age 35) (see Table 14).

REGION AND COUNTY OF COMMITMENT

In 2006, 53% of first releases were committed from New York City and 11% were committed from counties close to New York City. Inmates committed from Upstate counties with a major population center of at least 50,000 people made up 19% of releases, while those inmates from the remaining Upstate counties made up another 16% of the first releases in 2006. Nearly 24% of females and 16% of males were committed from non-urban upstate counties. Conversely, 54% of males and 46% of females were committed from New York City.
