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Statistical Overview

Year 2010 Court Commitments

This document describes the characteristics of inmates admitted to the New York State Department of Correctional Services during calendar year 2010 (N=23,255). The report concentrates on inmates admitted into a state prison facility for the first time on their current sentence (N=14,754). This overview presents information on various data points such as commitment offense, felony class, category of commitment offense, age at commitment, county of commitment and minimum sentence length. For comparative purposes, multiple tables throughout the report show trends in admission data across the years 2006 through 2010. Additionally, for comparison purposes, one table (Table 8.3) is included that shows the proportion of new commitments by gender between 1980 and 2010.

Statistical Overview

Year 2010 Admissions

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Section 1: Type of Admission

There were a total of 23,255 admissions to the facilities of the Department of Correctional Services during 2010. Of the total admissions, 14,754 (63%) were new court commitments, another 7,889 (34%) were returned parole violators, and 612 (3%) were other admissions.

(2010 Total Admissions, N=23,255)



Section 2: Commitment Offense

The total number of new court commitments decreased by 2,113 (16,867 to 14,754), or 13%, between 2006 and 2010. Within offense type, the most change occurred among drug and violent felony offenders. The number of drug offenders decreased by 38%, representing the most significant change, while the number of violent felony offenders increased by 9% over the five year period.

Between 2006 and 2010, the proportion of offenders committed for VFOs increased from 29% to 36%, while the proportion committed for drug offenses decreased from 36% to 25%. As a result, in 2006, the largest proportion of new commitments were drug offenders (36%), while the largest percent (36%) of new court commitments in 2010 were violent felony offenders.

Section 3: Felony Offender Status

More than half (57%) of the new court commitments received in 2010 were sentenced as first felony offenders. Among offenders committed to state prison for a violent felony offense, there was a higher concentration of individuals sentenced as first felony offenders (69%) when compared with other crimes. However, it should be noted that some inmates sentenced as first felony offenders were convicted of prior felony crimes and some even had previous sentences to state prison. Many of these inmates were convicted of Class A-1 violent felony crimes, which do not permit sentencing as a second felony offender since the penalties for A-1 violent felony crimes are already the most severe.

Section 4: Felony Class Category

The New York State Penal Law classifies felonies, for the purpose of sentence, into five categories as follows: Class A, B, C, D, and E. Class A represents the most severe offenses, and Class E the least. Class A felonies are further sub-classified for the purpose of sentencing, as A-I and A-II.¹ About 3% of 2010 new court commitments were Class A-I or Class A-II felons. Eighty-two percent (186 of 228) of the A-I commitments were for violent felony offenses. Nearly all Class A-II felons (242 of 267) were committed for drug crimes. The remaining 9% represent predatory sex offenders (as defined by NYS Penal Law Sections 130.95 and 130.96 enacted in 2006).

Class D felons were the largest felony class, encompassing 34% of new commitments in 2010.

(2010 New Commitment Population, N=14,754)



Section 5: *Minimum and Maximum Sentences*

The minimum sentence reflects the shortest period of time that a person must serve before being considered for release on parole.

The average minimum sentence for violent felons decreased from 80 months in 2006 to 77 months in 2010. For non-violent felons, there was very little change in the average minimum sentence between 2006 and 2010 (see Table 5.3 and Fig. 5.1). However, the overall minimum sentence for all types of crime increased from 41 to 44 months between 2006 and 2010. This phenomenon occurred as a result of the dramatic shift in the composition of crimes in the admission cohorts (refer to Section 2 in this report).

(2006-2010 New Court Commitments)



(2010 New Court Commitments, N=14,754)



While the median minimum sentence is 26 months, 14% of the new commitments received in 2010 were required to serve 6 years or more before they will be eligible for release to parole supervision (see Tables 5.1 and 5.2).



Section 6: Prior Adult Criminal Record

Nearly 56% of new court commitments in 2010 had served a prior period of time in jail (28%) or prison (28%).

Section 7: Drug Commitments

Of those new commitments admitted in 2010 for a drug offense, the majority (55%) were incarcerated for drug sale.

The number of drug commitments increased slightly from 2006 (6,060) to 2007 (6,148), but then declined by 2,392 or 39% from 2007 to 2010 (3,756). The Drug Law Reforms enacted in 2009 contributed to this decrease. Specifically, this legislation provides judges with sentencing discretion for certain drug offenders with substance abuse problems. This has diverted some drug offenders from prison to treatment programs in the community.²

Determinate sentencing for drug offenders began in 2005 following the Drug Law Reforms of 2004 (see Section 16 of this report). The determinate sentencing laws have resulted in a significant drop in average maximum sentences among drug offenders from 42 months in 2006 to 35 months in 2010, while the minimum sentences remained fairly stable over the same period (see Table 7.4).



Section 8: Gender

Males made up 94% of 2010 new court commitments. Approximately 96% of newly committed violent felons were men.

The proportion of men who were violent felons (37%) was significantly higher than the proportion of women who were violent felons (24%), whereas women were more likely than men to be committed for drug offenses (29% and 25%, respectively) and property offenses (35% and 21%, respectively).

Section 9: Race/Ethnic Status

Over the 2006 to 2010 period, just under half of new commitments annually have been African-Americans. The proportion of Whites in the admission group rose slightly between 2006 and 2010, while the proportion of African-Americans decreased slightly. The proportion of Hispanics was fairly stable at 27%.

Within offense categories, there were some changes in racial/ethnic composition between 2006 and 2010. Among drug offenders, the proportion of Whites increased from 11% in 2006 to 14% in 2010, while the proportion of African-Americans decreased from 56% to 49%. However, among violent felony offenders, the proportion of Hispanics increased slightly from 27% to 28%, while the proportion of Whites decreased from 20% to 18%.

Section 10: Age at Admission

Average age at admission has remained stable, at 32 years old, over the period 2006 through 2010. The percentage of new court commitments ages 50 to 59 increased from 5% in 2006 to 7% in 2010, while the proportion of commitments ages 35-39 decreased from 12% to 10%.

Section 11: County and Region of Commitment

Nearly half (46%) of new court commitments in 2010 were from New York City boroughs. The percentage of new court commitments from New York City remained relatively constant between 2006 and 2010 (with the exception of 2008).

A higher proportion of men were from New York City than women (47% and 39%, respectively) offset by a higher proportion of women who were committed from rural Upstate counties than men (27% and 20%, respectively).

Commitments from New York City, suburban New York City, and Upstate Urban were most likely to be violent felony offenders (39%, 48% and 39% respectively) while commitments from rural Upstate counties were most likely to be property offenders (39%). New York City had the largest proportion of drug offender commitments (29%).

(2010 New Court Commitments, N=14,754)



Section 12: Country of Birth

Approximately 88% of 2010 new court commitments were born in the United States or in U.S. possessions, 5% in a Caribbean nation, 2% in South America, and approximately 5% in all other countries. Among foreign-born commitments, 45% were born in the Caribbean region, while 26% (420 of 1,641) were born in the Dominican Republic.

Among new commitments born in the United States or in U.S. possessions, 35% were committed for VFOs and 23% were committed for property offenses; in contrast, among foreign-born commitments, 44% were committed for VFOs and 18% were committed for property offenses.

(2010 New Court Commitments, N=14,754)



Section 13: Marital Status

Among 2010 new court commitments, 73% reported that they were single, never married; 2% reported common law marriages; 15% reported that they were married, and 10% were divorced, separated or widowed.

Women were more likely than men to report that they were married (18% and 15%, respectively) or had been married (17% and 10%, respectively).

Section 14: Jail Time

Time spent in local jail prior to commitment to state prison is credited toward service of the minimum term. Average jail time served by new commitments in 2010 was 7.7 months. This number increased from 6.7 months in 2006 to 7.7 months in 2010 (see Table 14.1).

While jail time among Upstate inmates was stable between 2006 and 2010, it increased among those from New York City (8.1 to 9.6 months) and Suburban New York (6.8 to 9.2 months). On average, from 2006-2010, inmates from New York City (8.9 months) and Suburban New York (7.8 months) spent more time in local jails than inmates from Upstate Urban (5.2 months) and Upstate Other (5.0 months) counties (see Table 14.2).

Section 15: Life Without Parole

A person convicted of the crimes of murder in the first degree or aggravated murder may be sentenced to life imprisonment without parole. Persons sentenced to 'Life Without Parole' are not eligible for parole or conditional release.

In 2010, twelve men were admitted to NYS prison facilities with a Life Without Parole sentence. Of these twelve cases, half were committed from New York City

Of the 70 people admitted to DOCS in the five year period 2006-2010 with a Life Without Parole sentence, the youngest offender was 21 years old at admission to DOCS, while the oldest was 61 years old.

Section 16: *Determinate Sentencing*

Inmates with determinate sentences for their crime of commitment encompassed 61% of new court commitments in 2010. Over half (57%) of new commitments with a determinate sentence were first felony offenders (see Table 16.1).

The total number of determinately sentenced new commitments decreased from 9,538 in 2006 to 8,945 in 2010 (see Table 16.2). Determinately sentenced drug cases decreased from 5,015 in 2006 to 3,735 in 2010 (see Table 16.2). The proportion of determinately sentenced drug cases increased from 81% in 2006 to 98% in 2010 (see Table 16.3), while the proportion of determinately sentenced VFOs increased from 92% in 2006 to 94% in 2010.

Commitments with Determinate Sentences by Crime, 2006 - 2010


