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
**Indictments, Felony Dispositions, and Pending Felonies
New York State: The Thirteen Judicial Terms of 2011
(Based on the Office of Court Administration Caseload Activity Report)**

INDICTMENTS: Through the thirteen terms of 2011, the total number of indictments decreased by 4% (or -2,277 cases) compared to the thirteen terms of 2010. This decrease occurred in New York City, down 7% (or -1,571 cases) and the Upstate, Other region, down 4% (or -742 cases). The Suburban New York City region, increased slightly by 0.5% (or +36 cases).



FELONY DISPOSITIONS: Through the thirteen terms of 2011, the total number of felony dispositions decreased by 3% (or -1,335 cases) compared to the thirteen terms of 2010. Regionally, New York City decreased by 3% (or -704 cases) and Suburban New York City decreased by 1% (or -117 cases). The Upstate, Other region decreased by 3% (or -514 cases).

PENDING FELONY CASES: The total number of New York State pending felony cases awaiting disposition at the close of the thirteenth term of 2011 decreased by 0.5% (or -104 cases) compared to the close of the thirteenth term of 2010. Regionally, New York City decreased by 5% (or -661 cases). The Upstate, Other region increased by 11% (or +430 cases) and the Suburban NYC region increased by 7% (or +127 cases).




PENDING FELONY CASES (6 months or more): The total number of felony dispositions pending for six months or more decreased slightly by 0.4% (or -35 cases) from 9,180 at the close of the thirteenth term in 2010 to 9,145 at the close of the thirteenth term in 2011. Regionally, New York City decreased by 3% (or -226 cases) while Suburban New York City increased by 26% (or +80 cases) and the Upstate, Other region increased by 19% (or +111 cases). These long term pending dispositions tend to be more serious crimes.



PENDING SENTENCE CASES: Statewide, the number of offenders convicted, but still awaiting sentence decreased by 5% (or -710 cases) from 15,748 at the close of the thirteenth term in 2010 to 15,038 at the close of the thirteenth term in 2011. New York City decreased by 9% (or -714 cases). The Rest of the State increased by less than 1% (or +4 cases).
