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**ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
CALENDAR YEAR 2012**

INMATE POPULATION The inmate population in DOCCS facilities dropped by 1,201 inmates (-2.2%) from the end of 2011 to the end of 2012. The number of state ready inmates stood at 265 at the close of 2012 compared to 400 at the close of 2011, down 135 (-33.8%).

INCARCERATED PAROLEE POPULATION The incarcerated parolee population in DOCCS facilities increased by 87 parolees (+16.0%) from the end of 2011 to the end of 2012. The number of state ready parolees stood at 18 at the close of 2012, down 1 from the previous year.

INMATE ADMISSIONS Total inmate admissions for calendar year 2012 (CY 2012) at 23,738 were 1.6% or 378 below the 24,116 recorded during this period in 2011. Court commitments decreased by 407 (-2.8%) from 14,496 to 14,089. Technical violators increased by 74 (+1.0%). There were 1,805 participants admitted to an Alternative treatment program in 2012, up 51 (+2.9%) from 2011. Other admissions decreased by 96 from 481 to 385 (-20.0%). The 12-month average of admissions increased in the Technical Violators and the Alternative Cases categories, while declining in the remaining categories.

INCARCERATED PAROLEE ADMISSIONS Total incarcerated parolee admissions for CY 2012 at 2,685 were 13.6% or 321 above the 2,364 recorded during this period in 2011. Willard Judicially Sanctioned (JS) admissions increased by 16 (+3.0%) from 537 to 553. Willard violator (PV) diversions increased by 19 (+1.8%). There were 636 participants admitted to Edgecombe Residential Treatment in 2012, down 111(-14.9%) from 2011. There were 397 participants admitted to the Parole Diversion Program during 2012 (this program began at Orleans in February 2012 and at Hudson in November 2012). The 12-month average of incarcerated parolee admissions decreased in the Edgecombe Residential Treatment category, while increasing in the remaining categories.

INMATE RELEASES There were 24,935 inmates released from DOCCS facilities during CY 2012, which were 392 fewer (-1.5%) than the 25,327 released during calendar year 2011. Parole releases accounted for 8,335 of the CY 2012 releases compared to 8,323 in 2011, up 12 (+0.1%). Conditional releases at 10,326 were 4.1% below the 10,773 in 2011 (-447 conditional releases), while releases at maximum expiration of sentence increased by 27 (+1.0%). There were 1,830 cases released following participation in the Alternative treatment program, up 122 (+7.1%) from 2011. Maximum expiration of sentences with post-release supervision decreased by 63 (-5.1%) compared to the prior year. Other releases decreased from 632 to 589 (-6.8%). The 12-month average of releases increased in the maximum expiration, Parole and Alternate Program Cases categories, while decreasing in all other release categories.

INCARCERATED PAROLEE RELEASES There were 2,607 incarcerated parolees released from DOCCS facilities during CY 2012, which were 206 more (+8.6%) than the 2,401 released in 2011. Willard Judicially Sanctioned releases accounted for 553 of the CY 2012 releases compared to 538 in 2011, up 15 (+2.8%). The number of Willard violator diversion releases at 1,098 were 1.2% below the 1,111 in 2011 (-13 releases). The number of parolee participants released from Edgecombe Residential Treatment decreased by 113 (-15.0%). There were 317 parolee participants released from the Parole Diversion Program during 2012 (this program began at Orleans in February 2012 and at Hudson in November 2012). The 12-month average of releases increased in the Parole Diversion and Willard JS categories, while decreasing in all other release categories.

Figure 1. Inmate Admissions to the Facilities of the Department of Corrections and Community Supervision




Figure 3. Inmate Releases from the Facilities of the Department of Corrections and Community Supervision



