
**Indictments, Felony Dispositions, and Pending Felonies  
New York State: The Thirteenth Judicial Term of 2012  
(Based on the Office of Court Administration Caseload Activity Report)**

**INDICTMENTS:** The total number of indictments reported during the thirteen judicial terms of 2012 was 3% (or -1,391 cases) lower than the total for the thirteen terms of 2011. This decrease occurred in the New York City region, down 3%, (or -687 cases) and in the Suburban New York City region, down 10% (or -785 cases). The Upstate, Other region increased by less than 1% (or +81 cases).



**FELONY DISPOSITIONS:** The total number of Felony Dispositions reported during the thirteen judicial terms of 2012 was 3% (or -1,561 cases) lower than the total for the thirteen terms of 2011. This decrease occurred in the New York City region, down 5%, (or -1,194 cases) and in the Suburban New York City region, down 5% (or -395 cases). The Upstate, Other region increased less than 1% (or +28 cases).

**PENDING FELONY CASES:** At the close of the thirteenth judicial term of 2012, there was a total 18,654 pending felony cases. This was 6% (or -1,093 cases) lower than the total number of pending felony cases at the close of the thirteenth term in 2011. The New York City region decreased by 2% (or -221 cases) while the Suburban New York City region decreased by 9% (or -174 cases) and Upstate, Other region decreased by 17% (or -698 cases).




**PENDING FELONY CASES (6 months or more)** The total number of felony dispositions pending for six months or more decreased 4% (or -394 cases) from 9,145 at the close of the thirteenth term in 2011 to 8,751 at the close of the thirteenth term in 2012. This decrease occurred in the New York City region, down 2% (or -167 cases), the Suburban New York City region, down less than 1% (or -3 cases) and in the Upstate, Other region, down 33% (or -224 cases).



**PENDING SENTENCE CASES:** At the close of the thirteenth term of 2012 the total number of offenders convicted, but still awaiting sentence was 14,667. This total was 2% (or -371 cases) lower than the total at the close of the thirteenth term in 2011. Regionally, New York City showed a decrease of 7% (or -483 cases) while the Rest of the State showed an increase of 1% (or +112 cases) between the close of the thirteenth term of 2011 and the close of the thirteenth term of 2012.
