
**Indictments, Felony Dispositions, and Pending Felonies  
New York State: The Thirteenth Judicial Term of 2013  
(Based on the Office of Court Administration Caseload Activity Report)**

**INDICTMENTS:** The total number of indictments reported during the thirteen judicial terms of 2013 was 1% (or +291 cases) higher than the total for the thirteen terms of 2012. This increase occurred in the New York City region, up 2% (or +365 cases). The Suburban New York City region decreased by less than 1% (-19 cases) and the Upstate, Other region decreased by less than 1% (or -55 cases).



**FELONY DISPOSITIONS:** The total number of Felony Dispositions reported during the thirteen judicial terms of 2013 was 1% (or + 725 cases) higher than the total for the thirteen terms of 2012. The New York City region increased by 5% (or +1,150 cases). The Upstate, Other region decreased by 1% (or -274 cases) and the Suburban New York City region decreased by 2% (or -151 cases).

**PENDING DISPOSITIONS:** At the close of the thirteenth judicial term of 2013, there was a total of 18,488 total pending felony cases. This was 1% (or -166 cases) lower than the total number of pending felony cases at the close of the thirteenth term in 2012. The New York City region decreased by 6% (or -833 cases) and the Suburban New York City region decreased by 1% (or -15 cases). The Upstate, Other region increased by 20% (or +682 cases).



**PENDING DISPOSITIONS (6 months or more)** The total number of felony dispositions pending for six months or more decreased 7% (or -577 cases) from 8,751 at the close of the thirteenth term in 2012 to 8,174 at the close of the thirteenth term in 2013. This decrease occurred in the New York City region, which decreased by 10% (or -781 cases). The Suburban New York City region increased by 12% (or +48 cases) and the Upstate, Other region increased by 34% (or +156 cases).





**PENDING SENTENCE CASES:** At the close of the thirteenth term of 2013, the total number of offenders convicted, but still awaiting sentence, was 14,269. This total was 3% (or -398 cases) lower than the total at the close of the thirteenth term in 2012. The New York City region showed a decrease of 9% (or -624 cases). Regionally, the Rest of the State showed an increase of 3% (or +226 cases) between the close of the thirteenth term of 2012 and the close of the thirteenth term of 2013.
