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
## Indictments, Felony Dispositions, and Pending Felonies New York State: The Thirteenth Judicial Term of 2014 (Based on the Office of Court Administration Caseload Activity Report)

**INDICTMENTS:** The total number of indictments reported during the thirteen judicial terms of 2014 was 7% (or -3,491 cases) lower than the total for the thirteen terms of 2013. This decrease occurred statewide, specifically in the New York City region, down 11% (or -2,383 cases); the Suburban NYC region, down 5% (or -378 cases); and in the Upstate, Other region, down 4% (or -730 cases).



**FELONY DISPOSITIONS:** The total number of felony dispositions reported during the thirteen judicial terms of 2014 was 8% (or -3,809 cases) lower than the total for the thirteen terms of 2013. This decrease occurred statewide, specifically in the New York City region, down 12% (or -2,831 cases); the Suburban NYC region, down 8% (or -581 cases); and in the Upstate, Other region, down 2% (or -397 cases).

**PENDING FELONY CASES:** At the close of the thirteenth judicial term of 2014, there was a total of 18,017 pending felony cases. This was 3% (or -471 cases) lower than the total number of pending felony cases at the close of the thirteenth term in 2013. Regionally, the New York City region decreased by less than 1% (or -18 cases); and the Upstate, Other region decreased by 11% (or -454 cases); while the Suburban New York City region increased by less than 1% (or +1 case).



**PENDING FELONY CASES (6 months or more)** The total number of felony dispositions pending for six months or more increased by 4% (or +292 cases) from 8,174 at the close of the thirteenth term in 2013 to 8,466 at the close of the thirteenth term in 2014. This increase was driven by the Upstate, Other Region, which increased by 17% (or +107 cases); the Suburban New York City region, which increased by 3% (or +14 cases); and the New York City region, which increased by 2% (or +171 cases).





**PENDING SENTENCE CASES:** At the close of the thirteenth term of 2014, the total number of offenders convicted, but still awaiting sentence, was 14,278. This was less than 1% (or +9 cases) higher than the total at the close of the thirteenth term in 2013 and was the result of an 8% (or -510 case) decrease in the New York City region and a 6% (or +519 case) increase in Rest of State.
