ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES CALENDAR YEAR 2016 (Preliminary Data¹)

INMATE POPULATION: The inmate population in Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS) facilities dropped by 1,027 inmates (-2.0%) from the end of December 2015 to the end of December 2016. The number of state ready inmates stood at 461 at the close of December 2016, compared to 485 at the close of December 2015, down 24 (-4.9%).

INCARCERATED PAROLEE POPULATION: The incarcerated parolee population in DOCCS facilities increased by 149 parolees (+24.8%) from the end of December 2015 to the end of December 2016. The number of state ready parolees stood at 22 at the close of December 2016, up 4 (+22.2%) from the previous year.

INMATE ADMISSIONS: Total inmate admissions for CY 2016 at 21,675 were +0.9% or 192 above the 21,483 recorded for CY 2015. Court commitments increased by 240 (+1.9%) from 12,633 to 12,873. Technical violators decreased by 57 (-0.9%). There were 2,058 participants admitted to an Alternative treatment program in 2016, up 228 (+12.5%) from 2015. Other admissions decreased by 219 (-35.1%).

INCARCERATED PAROLEE ADMISSIONS: Total incarcerated parolee admissions for CY 2016 at 3,391 were 21.4% or 598 above the 2,793 recorded for CY 2015. Willard Judicially Sanctioned (JS) admissions increased by 51 (+7.7%) from 2015. Willard violator (PV) diversions increased by 71 (+7.1%). There were 641 participants admitted to Edgecombe Residential Treatment in 2016, up 129 (+25.2%) from 2015. There were 964 participants admitted to Parole Diversion and Other Programs during 2016, an increase of 347 (+56.2%) from 2015.

² In 2016, the Department changed the method of categorizing parolees incarcerated to participate in the RTF and RESET programs. This change resulted in offenders who were previously categorized as inmates moving into the incarcerated parolee category. As a result, much of the change in the inmate "Other Admissions" and the incarcerated parolee "Parole Diversion and Other Programs" admissions is due to this change in categorizations.

INMATE RELEASES: There were 22,628 inmates released from DOCCS facilities during CY 2016, which was 274 more (+1.2%) than the 22,354 released during 2015. Parole releases accounted for 7,358 of the CY 2016 releases compared to 7,492 in 2015, down 134 (-1.8%). Conditional releases at 8,834 were 2.4% below the 9,051 in 2015 (-217 conditional releases), while releases at maximum expiration of sentence increased by 66 (+2.9%). There were 1,981 cases released following participation in the Alternative treatment program, up 265 (+15.4%) from 2015. Maximum expiration of sentences with post-release supervision increased by 247 (+20.0%) compared to CY 2015. Other releases increased from 560 to 607 (+8.4%).

INCARCERATED PAROLEE RELEASES: There were 3,315 incarcerated parolees released from DOCCS facilities during CY 2016, which was 639 more (+23.9%) than the 2,676 parolees released in 2015. Willard Judicially Sanctioned releases accounted for 671 of the CY 2016 releases compared to 654 in 2015, up 17 (+2.6%). The number of Willard Violator diversion releases at 1,079 was 90 more than the 989 in 2015 (+9.1%). The number of parolee participants released from Edgecombe Residential Treatment increased by 120 (+23.5%). There were 934 parolee participants released from Parole Diversion and Other Programs during CY 2016, an increase of 412 (+78.9%) from 2015.
