

Gowanda Correctional Facility Visiting Schedule

Visitation for the general population occurs on an “odd/even” schedule, based on the last digit of an inmate’s DIN and the date of the month. Example: inmate’s DIN is 99A2223; he could have visits on any visiting day that ends in an odd number, i.e. 3rd, 9th, 17th, etc. When the 31st is on a Saturday, the 1st of the month will be considered an “even” day. When a holiday falls on a weekday (Mon-Fri), the off/even schedule is waived. This will allow any inmate in general population to get a visit.

The odd/even visitation schedule does not apply:

- To first time visitors, in accordance with Directive #4403, Section III, G
- For special events
- To inmates housed in the Special Housing Unit who are entitled to one visit per week per Departmental directive #4933
- To inmates housed in the Infirmary:
 - Visiting hours begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 2:00 p.m. in the infirmary to allow for the escorting of visitors out of the facility
 - Medical staff may determine the length of all visits, taking into consideration the condition of the inmate patient
 - Inmates are to wear Infirmary attire

The only other exception to the odd/even visitation schedule is for out of state visitors from the inmate’s immediate family. The out of state visitor must make a request in writing to the Superintendent, at least 21 days prior to the desired visit date, for consideration and approval. Confirmation will be sent by mail.
