Moriah Shock Incarceration Correctional Facility Visiting Room Rules and Regulations New York State Department of Corrections & Community Supervision

Directive 4403, governs the inmates' visitor program. Shock procedures are more stringent in some cases than those of a general confinement facility because of the nature of the program.

NOTICE: Any violation of the rules listed below may result in immediate termination of the visit.

01. Visit hours- 9:00 am to 3:00 pm - scheduled Sundays only. Inmates are to maintain proper military bearing during visits.
02. Limit of three visitors per inmate, plus two lap children (Toddler 4 years old and under who are able to sit on someone's lap all day) may be included with these three visitors.
03. Children must be supervised by a parent or guardian and will be expected to behave and stay within limits of their visiting area. Parents are responsible for their children at all times.
04. Visitors must present proper identification and documentation to enter.
05. Only items allowed in the visiting room are: a small change purse; playing cards; photos (no more than 20 loose); 2 infant diapers; 2 infant bottles; baby wipes and receiving blanket.
06. Visitors must enter the following information in the "Visitors Log Book" date, visitor's complete address, locker key #, inmate's name and DIN, visitor time in and out. No hats or outerwear allowed in the visiting room.
07. No packages allowed at this facility.
08. Smoking not allowed in any facility building.
09. Food from vending machines shall be consumed in visiting room only. Only visitors may make purchases. Inmates are not allowed to use the machines.
10. No pets, cameras, cell phones, pagers, lap top computers, radios, tape players, alcoholic beverages, firearms, or illegal drugs are allowed in the facility.
11. Inmates and visitor(s) are not allowed to leave the visiting area together for any reason.
12. Physical contact is to be kept to a minimum. Kissing and embracing is acceptable only at the beginning and the end of the visit.
13. Visitors are allowed to visit only with the inmate that they have requested to visit. Cross visiting is only allowed with the special permission of the Superintendent.
14. Once a visitor leaves the visiting area, he/she will not be allowed back in.
15. All vehicles are to be secured while parked on facility grounds.
16. Upon entering or leaving the facility, there is to be no stopping or loitering.
17. Due to limited visiting space, if overcrowding occurs in the visiting area, visits will be terminated by the supervisor in charge. If termination is required it will be based on frequency of visiting, distance traveled, geographic location, length of visit, and related factors.
18. Exchange of any item between visitor and inmate is prohibited.
19. Visitors may leave a maximum of \$50.00 for an inmate's account



Directions to Moriah Shock Incarceration Correctional Facility

TRAVEL INFORMATION: MORIAH S.I.C.F. IS LOCATED IN ESSEX COUNTY, NEW YORK, IN THE VILLAGE OF MINEVILLE. THERE ARE NO PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES. FROM NEW YORK CITY (BY CAR): Take the New York State Thruway (87) to Exit 24 (Albany). FROM ALBANY: Take the Adirondack Northway (I-87) north toward Montreal. Get off Exit 30; turn right on US 9 South; Go 1/10 of a mile; turn left onto County Route 6 (Moriah Shock Sign); go 10 ½ miles to the end of this road; straight through 2 stop signs; turn left onto County Route 7 (Moriah Shock sign); go 2 miles to the facility which is on the right side of the road. (Trip time from NYC is approximately 6 hours; from Albany 2 ½ hours).

DIRECCIONES: MORIAH S.I.C.F. ESTA LOCALIZADA EN ESSEX COUNTY, NEW YORK, CERCA DE LA VILLA DE MINEVILLE. DESDE LA CIUDAD DE NEW YORK: Tome el New York State Thruway (87) a la salida numero 24 (EXIT 24). FTome el Adirondack Northway (I-87) norte para Montreal. Salga en la salida nemero 30 (EXIT 30); doble a la derecha en la ruta numero US9 sur; siga 1/10 milla (200 metros) y doble a la izquierda en County Route 6 (Moriah Shock); prosiga 10 ½ millas hast una intercepcion "T" (Moriah Shock); doble a la izquierda y prosiga 2 millas hasta llegar al institucion que se encontrara a la derecha de la ruta.
