



**Auburn C.F donates \$1,700 to local charities

Civilian employees at Auburn Correctional Facility (Cayuga County) are allowed to wear "Jeans on Fridays" if they contribute one dollar to a local community fundraiser. During 2013, a total of \$1,700 was donated to local charities throughout the community.

\$600 of that money was donated to the Christmas Elf Program. In its 26<sup>th</sup> year, the Christmas Elf helps support low-income families who are in need during the holiday season. The Elf provides each child with gifts and the families with a \$25 dollar Wegmans gift card to help with the groceries during the winter break.
