

Osborne Association FamilyWorks Graduation at Sing Sing October 30, 2014

On October 22nd, the <u>Osborne Association</u> celebrated the graduation of 47 inmates from the parenting and relationship program at Sing Sing, a program called FamilyWorks. This ceremony celebrates the achievement and commitment of FamilyWorks graduates. The program included speeches and remarks by program graduates as well as comments from facility Superintendent Michael Capra and Deputy Superintendent of Programs Lesley Malin.

FamilyWorks is a collaboration with the NYS Department of Corrections and Community Supervision and was the first parenting program in a men's state prison. For the last 29 years, it has enabled incarcerated dads to make, mend, and maintain relationships with their children through a comprehensive program that includes *Basic Parenting, Strengthening Relationships, Connected Couples*, and the *Fatherhood Forum*.
