



Current DOCCS Parole Officer Training Class will Prepare 40 new officers

In an effort to keep up with attrition, 40 men and women started training December 1st to become New York State Parole Officers. The current group of recruits have come from across the state to take part in the eight weeks of classes where upon completion the recruits will immediately be assigned to three weeks of on the job training to work out of several bureaus located in New York City, sometime in February. The current Parole Officer class is the second in two years. Previously it had been six years, prior to the Department of Correctional Services and Division of Parole merger, that a training class was held.
