Martin Luther King, Jr. Food Drive at Orleans Correctional Facility

Orleans Correctional Facility took part in their annual Martin Luther King, Jr. food drive hosted by the facility's Diversity Management committee. Members of each union were encouraged to have friendly competition to see who could donate the most food. A total of 614 servings and 188 pounds of food was donated to the Orleans Community Action, a non-profit organization that helps provide food, shelter and clothing to less fortunate people in Orleans County. Management Confidential employees teamed up with Council 82 and brought in the most servings with 324 followed by Public Employees Federation (PEF) with 239, Civil Service Employees Association (CSEA) with 45, and New York State Correctional Officers & Police Benevolent Association (NYSCOPBA) with 6.
