



Former Fulton Correctional Facility Officially Becomes Reentry Center

The former Fulton Correctional Facility is now the home to [a new reentry center overseen by the Osborne Association](#). During a ceremony held January 29th the Osborne Association officially became the owners of the former Fulton facility. The group will convert the building into a reentry center offering interim housing, social services and job training for individuals leaving New York jails and prisons. Citing lower crime and a declining prison population, Fulton was one of 13 prisons Governor Cuomo ordered closed since taking office in 2011. The Osborne Association is a great partner of DOCCS as they oversee the very successful and effective Family Works program. Acting DOCCS Commissioner Anthony J. Annucci attended and spoke at the ceremony held in the Bronx.
