### Request for Applications (RFA), 2017-01 Community Based Residential Programs

DOCCS is providing a clarification for RFA 2017-01. Currently, the RFA provides the following requirements in Section I, *Purpose*, (page 4) *Only one program site is allowed per application; Separate applications must be submitted for each location within a Catchment Area or for a location in another Catchment Area.* And (page 5) *Please note that a provider can submit more than one application for any Catchment Area; however, said application **must** be for different physical locations. In addition, the same physical location cannot be submitted for more than one Catchment Area.*

This RFA provides for new Catchment Area opportunities in Catchment Areas 1 (1A); 3 (3A); 7 (7A); 15 (15A); and 16 (16A). The purpose of providing more than one opportunity for the same gender group and geographic location is to increase the opportunities for applicants. Although increasing the opportunities is DOCCS' priority for adding the additional Catchment Areas, it is also possible for applicants to submit a separate application for the A option in the above-mentioned Catchment Areas with the same program location subject to final approval by DOCCS' Executive staff.

Please be aware that priority may be given to entities submitting applications for only one of the options. For example, if one applicant submits two applications ( one for Catchment Area 1 and the other for Catchment Area 1A) for two programs at the same location, and another applicant submits the application for one of those options, both applications would be scored the same. The results based on the scoring may be that the applicant that submits for both Catchment Areas 1 and 1A does not have the *best value* for one or the other of the two applications. DOCCS will use the scoring results and the requisite site visits to make the final determination in such cases.
