#	Question Received	DOCCS Response
1	Did this come from an existing contract?	The NYS Office of General Services (OGS) has contracts for Registered Nurses that DOCCS can utilize. When nurses are not available from OGS contractors, standby contracts that result from this bid will be utilized.

3	What is the total spend for this project?	The spend is dependent on the resultant low bids received.
4	When is the expected awarding date?	Tentative awards will be made soon after the bid opening date. A contract award is not made until the NYS Attorney General's Office and NYS Comptroller's Office has approved the contract.
5	Will the % mark-up be determined by the bidder also?	Yes.
6	How many references are preferred to be included in the proposal?	References are at the discretion of the bidder. They are not required with the bid submission but may be requested from DOCCS post bid. See page 18 of IFB#2018-08.
7	To clarify, all insurances are due UPON NOTIFICATION of award and not upon submission of proposal?	Insurance documentation is due upon notice of tentative contract award.
