ADDENDUM #1

PROJECT: Request For Applications (RFA) #2017-05
Inmate Vendor Food And Sundry Package Program

DATE: May 31, 2017

The Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS) is sending this information to all potential vendors.

RFA #2017-05 is being amended as follows:

1) Revised NYS Reserved Rights, Page 5, to add:

14. Terminate any approved vendor that is not in compliance with the terms stated herein and amendments hereto.

2) Revised Vendor Application Criteria Information, Page 5, Section 1(d) –

“A statement that the vendor has a minimum of the following: Three (3) years experience providing inmate packages in a manner as described on Page 8, #11. The systems must have been in full production servicing at least one (1) year for at least three (3) government agencies.”

Is hereby changed to read:

“A statement that the vendor has a minimum of the following: “One (1) year experience providing inmate packages in a manner as described on Page 8, #11. “The system must have been in full production servicing at least one (1) year for at least one (1) government agency.”

Any vendor that did not submit an application to RFA #2017-05 based on the original requirement of Section 1(d) that is now able to meet the amended requirement listed above must contact DOCCS at doccscontracts@doccs.ny.gov no later than June 7, 2017. DOCCS may consider further applications from vendors that prove to meet this requirement as amended above.
