FORMER COMPTROLLER ALAN HEVESI SCHEDULED FOR RELEASE

ALBANY – Former New York State Comptroller Alan Hevesi will be released from Mid-State Correctional Facility (Oneida County) at approximately 8:00 a.m. on December 12, 2012 following his November 14, 2012 Parole Board approval and the completion of a community preparation investigation.

The former Comptroller won approval on his second appearance before the Parole Board and served 20 months of his 1-to-4-year sentence imposed in New York County for Receiving Reward for Official Misconduct. Hevesi has been an inmate at DOCCS since April 15, 2011 and was housed at Mid-State's Protective Custody Unit since April 16, 2011. He will remain under community supervision until April 14, 2015 and will reside in Queens County. A complete list of the community supervision conditions is attached.
