ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES^d
CALENDAR YEAR 2008
(Preliminary Data)

INMATE POPULATION The inmate population in DOCS facilities dropped by 2,400 inmates (-3.8%) from the end of December 2007 to the end of December 2008. The number of state ready inmates stood at 371 at the close of December 2008 compared to 91 at the close of December 2007, up 280 (+307.7%).

ADMISSIONS Total admissions for calendar year 2008 at 26,901 were 3.4% or 959 below the 27,860 recorded during this period in 2007. Court commitments decreased by 1,436 (-8.3%) from 17,247 to 15,811. Technical violators decreased by 462 (-4.8%). There were 1,009 individuals admitted to and successfully participating in an Alternative treatment program in 2008 compared to 175 that were admitted in the first two months of operation in 2007. Other admissions increased from 733 to 838 (+14.3%). The 12 month average of admissions increased in the Alt Program cases and other categories, while declining in the remaining categories.

RELEASES There were 29,135 inmates released from DOCS facilities during calendar year 2008, which were 578 more (+2.0%) than the 28,557 released in 2007. Parole releases accounted for 11,265 of calendar year 2008 releases compared to 12,866 in 2007, down 1,601 (-12.4%). Conditional releases at 11,352 were 7.3% above the 10,584 in 2007 (+768 conditional releases), while releases at expiration of sentence rose by 331 (+10.8%). There were 896 cases released following successful completion of their Alternative treatment program. Maximum expiration of sentences with post-release supervision rose by 192 (+17.9%) compared to the prior year. Other releases decreased from 985 to 977 (-0.8%). The 12-month average of releases increased in all release categories except the parole and other categories which declined.




