ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES^{1/}
CALENDAR YEAR 2010
(Preliminary Data)

INMATE POPULATION The inmate population in DOCS facilities dropped by 2,063 inmates (-3.5%) from the end of 2009 to the end of 2010. The number of state ready inmates stood at 366 at the close of 2010 compared to 329 at the close of 2009, up 37 (+11.2%).

ADMISSIONS Total admissions for calendar year 2010 at 24,365 were 3.4% or 864 below the 25,229 recorded during this period in 2009. Court commitments decreased by 568 (-3.7%) from 15,323 to 14,755. Technical violators decreased by 374 (-4.5%). There were 1,119 successful participants admitted to an Alternative treatment program in 2010, up 78 (+7.5%) from 2009. Other admissions remained the same. The 12 month average of admissions increased in the Alternative Program cases category, while declining in the remaining categories.

RELEASES There were 26,394 inmates released from DOCS facilities during calendar year 2010, which were 545 fewer (-2.0%) than the 26,939 released in 2009. Parole releases accounted for 9,240 of calendar year 2010 releases compared to 9,569 in 2009, down 329 (-3.4%). Conditional releases at 11,077 were 3.0% below the 11,418 in 2009 (-341 conditional releases), while releases at expiration of sentence increased by 139 (+5.0%). There were 1,087 cases released following successful completion of their Alternative treatment program, up 122 cases (+12.6%) from 2009. Maximum expiration of sentences with post-release supervision decreased by 31 (-2.3%) compared to the prior year. Other releases decreased from 869 to 764 (-12.1%). The 12-month average of releases increased in Alternate Program Cases and Maximum Expiration categories, while decreasing in all other release categories.




