NEW YORK STATE FELONY PROCESSING: CALENDAR YEAR 2012*

ARRESTS: Statewide, total felony arrests for calendar year 2012 were down 0.4% (or -572 arrests) from the 157,304 arrests during calendar year 2011 to 156,732. This decrease in arrests occurred statewide with New York City, down 1.1% (or -958 arrests), Suburban New York City, down 2.2% (or -405 arrests), and Upstate area arrests up 1.6% (or 791 arrests) more than in 2011.

The ten largest arrest categories for 2011 and 2012 are shown in the table below. Three of these crime categories declined while seven increased. The three largest numeric changes in arrests from the prior year were: Drugs and Marijuana, down 1,277 arrests (or -4.1%), followed by Larceny, up 1,079 arrests (or 7.2%), and Hindering Prosecution up 673 arrests (or 4.9%).

INDICTMENTS: Statewide, total indictments for calendar year 2012 were down 3.5% from 2011 levels (or -1,723 indictments). This decrease in indictments occurred in all three regions, with New York City down 2.5% (-524 cases), Suburban New York City down 7.8% (-581 cases), and Upstate areas down 3.0% (-618 cases).

Among the largest indictment categories listed below, eight declined and two increased. The largest numeric changes in indictments were: Robbery, down 314 indictments (or -5.6%), Drugs and Marijuana, down 305 indictments (or -2.8%), and Larceny, down 295 indictments (or -7.5%).

DISPOSITIONS: Total State dispositions were down by 3.5% (or -1,713 dispositions) during calendar year 2012 as compared to 2011. This decrease in dispositions occurred in all three regions, with New York City down 4.8% (or -1,042 dispositions), Suburban New York City down 3.9% (or -286 dispositions), and Upstate areas down 1.9% (or -385 dispositions).

Among the largest disposition categories listed below, seven declined and three increased. The three crime categories with the greatest change in the number of dispositions were: Drug and Marijuana, down 685 dispositions (or -5.9%), followed by Assault, down 367 dispositions (or -9.0%), and Burglary, up 221 dispositions (or 4.6%).

CONVICTIONS: Total state convictions for 2012 decreased, down 3.5% from 2011 levels (or -1,380 convictions). The number of convictions that resulted in a sentence to state prison was down 3.7% to 15,266 compared to 15,856 in 2011 (or -590 sentences). During 2012, New York City had the highest proportion of state prison sentences at 42.7% compared to 28.2% for Suburban New York City and 41.7% for Upstate areas. The proportion of convictions resulting in prison increased for Upstate New York from 40.3% in 2011 to 41.7% in 2012.
