NEW YORK STATE FELONY PROCESSING: CALENDAR YEAR 2013 ¹

ARRESTS: Statewide, total felony arrests for calendar year 2013 were down less than 0.1% (or -71 arrests) from the 156,897 arrests during calendar year 2012 to 156,826. This decrease in arrests occurred in two regions with Suburban New York down 4.1% (or -744 arrests) and Upstate New York down 4.2% (or -2,096 arrests). Felony arrests in New York City were up 3.1% (or 2,769 arrests) compared to 2012.

The ten largest arrest categories for 2012 and 2013 are shown in the table below. Four of these crime categories declined while six increased. The three largest numeric changes in arrests from the prior year were: Burglary, down 439 arrests (or -3.5%), followed by Larceny, up 331 arrests (or 2.1%), and Hindering Prosecution, up 288 arrests (or 2.1%).

INDICTMENTS: Statewide, total indictments for calendar year 2013 were down 1.2% from 2012 levels (or -582 indictments). This decrease in indictments occurred in two regions of the State with Suburban New York down 6.9% (-480 cases) and Upstate New York down 1.4% (-274 cases). New York City increased 0.8% (172 cases).

Among the largest indictment categories listed below, eight declined and two increased. The largest numeric changes in indictments were: Drugs and Marijuana, down 305 indictments (or -2.8%), Assault, down 272 indictments (or -7.0%), and Larceny, down 237 indictments (or -6.1%).

DISPOSITIONS: Total State dispositions were down by 0.4% (or -179 dispositions) during calendar year 2013 as compared to 2012. This decrease in dispositions occurred in two regions with Suburban New York down 6.3% (or -447 dispositions) and Upstate New York down 2.2% (or -434 dispositions). New York City had an increase of 3.4% (or 702 dispositions).

Among the largest disposition categories listed below, seven declined and three increased. The three crime categories with the greatest change in the number of dispositions were: Drugs and Marijuana, down 685 dispositions (or -5.9%), followed by Assault, down 367 dispositions (or -9.3%), and Burglary, up 221 dispositions (or 4.3%).

CONVICTIONS: Total state convictions for 2013 increased, up 0.3% from 2012 levels (or 111 convictions). The number of convictions that resulted in a sentence to state prison was up 0.7% (or 104 convictions) to 15,456 compared to 15,352 in 2012. During 2013, Upstate New York had the highest proportion of state prison sentences at 41.8% compared to 30.2% for Suburban New York and 41.5% for New York City. The proportion of convictions resulting in prison increased for Suburban New York from 27.8% in 2012 to 30.2% in 2013.
